9th Annual Lil Miss Ripley County 3rd Annual Lil Mister Ripley County

This year, the Miss Ripley County Queen Committee will be crowning our nineth Lil Miss Ripley County Princess & Our third Lil Mister Ripley County at the 2025 Ripley County 4-H Fair. The pageant will take place on Wednesday, July 23rd. Each contestant will go through a small, informal interview. The contestants then will get time to meet and take pictures with the newly crowned Miss Ripley County 2025 and her court. The contestants then will walk on stage and answer an onstage question, and finally the judges will take time to make their final decision and we will crown our Lil Mister & Miss Ripley County Prince & Princess!!

Duties of the newly crowned prince & princess and their court will be as follows:

- * Passing out ribbons with the queen and her court
- * Riding in the Pumpkin Show Parade in September
- * Riding in the 4th of July Parade in Milan
- * Attending the 2026 Miss Ripley County Queen Pageant

Requirements

- The age category is Grade K-2nd Grade. (Contestants must have completed Kindergarten, 1st, or 2nd grade at the end of the 2024-2025 school year.)
- * There will be a \$30 entry fee that will need to be turned in with the application.
- * Each contestant must be a resident of Ripley County <u>and</u> must be a student at a Ripley County school. One of the contestant's parents or legal guardians must also be a Ripley County resident.
- * Transportation for contestants and chaperones to and from the pageant and the events the court will be participating in will be the responsibility of each contestant.
- * Each contestant must have a chaperone with them at all times during the pageant and events that the court will be participating in.
- * This will be an "All Natural" pageant. Contestants will not be permitted to wear any type of make-up.
- * Contestants will be required to wear a simple sundress for the girls & khakis & a polo for the boys for the pageant. They will not be scored on their dress.

- * Interview
- * Personality
- * Poise

- 1) Any Ripley County 4-H member who exhibits sheep, dairy goat, meat goat, horse & pony, dairy, beef, rabbit, swine or poultry will be allowed to consign an animal to the 4-H Auction prior to the completion of judging of that particular livestock show, providing he or she meets the following conditions:
 - No 4-H'er will be allowed to sell in the Auction unless 4-H'er is present to assist in weighing or has arranged for someone else to take care of weighing animals.
 - b) \$25 off of the sale price of the project will be deducted to be used for promotion, recognition of the buyers and permanent livestock building improvements.
 - c) 4-H'er must have picture taken at species scheduled time. No 4-H'er will sell at Auction unless picture is taken as scheduled tentatively for Wednesday:

7:00AM - 8:50AM → Swine

9:00AM - 11:45AM → Sheep, Poultry, Dairy Goats,

Meat Goats, and Dairy

 $11:00AM - 3:00 PM \rightarrow Beef (during beef show)$

5:00PM - 7:00PM → Rabbits & Anyone who

missed their animal's time

By Appointment → Horse & Pony

Tuesday: 5:30PM − 8:00PM → Anyone who cannot make their appointment time; MUST contact photographer to schedule.

*If any of these times do not work, you MUST contact the extension office prior to Monday at noon.

Members may sell only one animal in the auction. The species may be a beef steer, market lamb, swine barrow, market goats, dairy goat product, meat pen of rabbits, a meat pen of poultry, dairy product or Horse


& Pony basket (Grand only). The only exception granted is that if the member wins Grand/ Reserve Grand Champion with two species, the member may sell both their Grand/Reserve Grand Champion species. Should a member win Grand/ Reserve Grand Champion with more than two, a decision will be made by the 4-H Corporation.

- 3) All 4-H'ers must present their animals personally in the show ring for sale as follows:
 - a) Owners of market lambs or barrows drive their animals into the sale ring.
 - b) Owners of market goats will lead their animals into the sale ring.
 - c) Owners of steers lead the steer into the sale ring.
 - d) Owners of rabbits carry their rabbits into the sale
 - e) Owners of poultry carry their birds into the ring.
 - f) Only Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Dairy can auction and can sell a gallon of milk & a small cheese basket each.
 - g) Only Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Dairy Goat Doe can sell in the auction.
 - h) The price and variety of dairy products will be decided by the Dairy Superintendent and the dairy members.
- 4) Order of the sale will be Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Grand Champion Home Born & Raised, Reserve Grand Champion Home Born & Raised, and then other members in order by random drawing.
- 5) Arrangement and expense of hauling will be the responsibility of the buyer
- 6) Animals will be released at 8:00 pm Friday, July 25. Non-Auction animals will be released on Friday, 7 – 10 am or at 8pm (no release in between those times). Animals released before, after or between that time frame will be penalized.
- 7) Terms of sale, payment by the purchaser the night of the sale or within 1 week of the sale.
- 8) Remember: IT IS A PRIVILEGE to sell at the Ripley County 4-H LIVESTOCK Auction, let's not abuse this Privilege, either as a 4-H member or 4-H parent.

KID KEEP (revised animal buy back)

Kid Keep is for 4-Hers who want the option to take their market animal back home after the 4-H auction and not have it shipped if the buyer does not to choose to keep it.

- 1) If a 4-Her wants to keep their market animal after the auction, they must mark this on the yellow auction paper that is filled out the Sunday of fair when animals are entered. A parent and the 4-H member must sign this form.
- 2) Once entered to go through the auction, the auction buyer will always get the first option to keep the animal, regardless of if the 4-H put they would like to take it home. If the buyer decides to keep the animal, you do not get to take it home.



2025 Rules &

Regulations

- An exhibitor in a 4-H class must be a paid Ripley County 4-H member and enrolled in the project they exhibit.
- 2. Projects submitted for judging must be from a currently enrolled 4-H member of Ripley County 4-H and registered under the respective project.
- Members are limited to one exhibit in one section of each project except in the case livestock classes.
- All animals are to be possessed by and under the care of the 4-H member by the stated ownership deadline for each species.
- 5. Projects that require more than one article in any exhibit will be judged as a unit.
- 6. Upon submission of a project to the Fair, 4-H project record sheets should be filled out and initialed by an adult volunteer tasked with managing/assisting the respective project. 4-Hers with a 100% completion rate of at least two projects are eligible for a T-Shirt from the Extension Office.
- Adult 4-H leaders will see that all their respective club check-in forms are turned in at the Office during the Fair.
- All 4-H exhibits shall meet the requirements of the 4-H
 Club Division in which the member is enrolled. In the case
 of a misunderstanding, the current Indiana State Fair
 Catalog shall be the official guide.
- All exhibits shall be made or owned by the 4-H club member. However, a partnership agreement is possible in livestock.
- 10. 4-H animals must be shown by the 4-H member unless that 4-H member is ill, then another Ripley County 4-H member may substitute for the owner. Parents are prohibited from exhibiting livestock projects for their children unless explicit 4-H Corporation approval.
- 11. No livestock will be permitted on the fairgrounds 30 days prior to the start of the Fair.
- 12. All 22" x 28" poster exhibits must be on foam core only, covered with clear plastic, and mounted <u>horizontally</u>. Exhibitor tags must be in the lower right-hand corner. There may be exceptions in a photography project.
- Any poster project that receives a state fair entry <u>must be</u> on foam core and horizontal. Check with the Extension office for exceptions.
- 14. ENTRY DATES:
 - a. All 4-H Projects (except livestock) will be community judged on Saturday before the official Grand Opening from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm.
 - b. Pen Reservations must be paid & made at the County Extension Office by July 1st. The charge after July 1st will be \$25 per family.
 - c. Arrival Time: All Animals (except Poultry and Horse & Pony) must arrive at the fairgrounds Sunday of the Fair between 6:00 am and 2:00 pm.
 - d. 4-H Tractor Driving contest, Pocket Pets Judging, and Dog show will be held before Fair. Record books must be completed and presented at the time of each event. Please read your monthly

- e. 4-H newsletter for the dates of these events. These newsletters are emailed to the email address used in 4-H Online and posted on the Purdue Extension Ripley County website at https://Extension.purdue.edu/Ripley.
- 15. ALL 4-H ENTRIES will be under the control of the Superintendents. Superintendents will be tabled at each hall entrance to check-in 4-H exhibits. Superintendents are then responsible for displaying all stationary projects after the members have entered the projects.
- 16. SUPERINTENDENTS will take every precaution possible for the safekeeping of 4-H exhibits. However, the 4-H Corporation, Extension Educators, or Superintendents will not be held responsible for any loss or damage that might
- 17. 4-H Livestock Superintendents are responsible for securing proper equipment for manure disposal.
- 18. GRIEVANCES: Reference to the Indiana State Fair Book Rules under the Determination of Violations of terms and conditions. The grievance must be presented in writing within 24 hours for all livestock activities and before the official closing of the Ripley County 4-H Fair for all other activities.
- 19. In consultation with the 4-H Youth Educators and at least one 4-H Corporation member, the project Superintendent shall be responsible for interpreting any term or condition, policy, code of ethics, or prohibited activities during the Ripley County 4-H Fair.
- Release of Exhibits All 4-H projects will be released at 10:00 am on Saturday, the Fair's last day.
- 4-H Superintendents are responsible for seeing that someone from their department is present at the time of animal project release.
- Any article or animal may not be released from fairgrounds until approval is granted by the 4-H Corporation.
- It is the responsibility of the 4-H member or their guardians to make State Fair entries immediately after the judging.
- 24. All State-Fair Exhibits (except foods, floriculture, and garden) will be due to the Extension Office after project release or no later than 8:00 am on a designated date given during the Fair. Foods projects, potatoes, flowers, and garden and beekeeping exhibits will be due to the Extension office from 7:00 am to 8:00 am on a designated date given during the Fair. NO EXCEPTIONS. Projects can be taken to state fair by 4-H'er. Necessary paperwork must be obtained from the Extension Office.
- 25. Large 4-H projects and some fragile projects may be the responsibility of the 4-Her to transport to the state fair, per the Extension Educator's discretion. The necessary paperwork can be obtained at the Extension Office.
- An adult supervisor must accompany any 4-H Exhibitor staying overnight.
- The Extension Office will furnish 4-H exhibit labels. The Superintendents will see that labeling is complete at the time of entry.
- 28. To improve the Fair, any details within the printed program may be superseded by the decision of the 4-H Corporation Board.
- 29. Only approved protective headgear by ASTM/SEI F1163 must be worn for all contesting events and Hunt Seat classes. Headgear must be worn anytime while mounted.



- All 4-H Beef animals must be free of ringworm and warts when at the county fair.
- Only standard 4-H Awards approved by the 4-H Corporation will be given at the Awards Ceremony.
- Individuals wishing to participate in showmanship and not enrolled in the project will show in Novice Showmanship.
- 33. During Fair Week, the 4-H animal exhibitor may only receive clipping and grooming assistance from their immediate family, which is defined as a father, mother, stepfather, stepmother, legal guardian, brother, sister, grandfather, grandmother, aunt or uncle or from another Ripley County 4-H exhibitor, parent or leader.
- 34. All county and state projects will only be held at the Extension office until October 30th following the Fair. County Garden, Flowers, and Crops projects will be disposed of Saturday, the Fair's last day.

4-H STANDARDS AND PRACTICE

- Tampering, altering, and/or misrepresentation relative to any 4-H exhibit is prohibited.
- 2. Unnatural and unethical fitting of 4-H animal exhibits which alter the animal tissues is prohibited.
- 3. All 4-H animal projects must be free of drugs, steroids, and chemical or foreign substance residue as defined by USDA and FDA for sale as human food both the day of the show and on the day of shipment to market. All 4-H animals must remain within 50' of barns on the day of the show.
- 4. A 4-H exhibitor may not take exception to the decisions of an official in an unprofessional nor public manner, nor may they interfere with or show disrespect to any judge or official.
- Submission of an entry to the Ripley County Fair expressly binds the 4-H exhibitor to all terms, conditions, rules, and regulations in all parts of the Ripley County Fair Book and 4-H Livestock Enrollment forms.
- Animal ownership or lease must be in effect on or before the county/state 4-H enrollment deadline and continued until after the 4-H show date.
- All 4-H exhibits at the Ripley County fair must be prepared during the current 4-H year.
- Misconduct at the Ripley County fair by 4-H members will subject them to disciplinary penalties for any one or more of the following:
 - Dishonesty by cheating and/or knowingly furnishing false information.
 - b. Alteration or unauthorized use of 4-H records.
 - Obstruction or disruption or aiding and encouraging others to engage in such conduct.
 - d. Failure to comply or helping/encouraging others not to comply.
