

# Health & Safety Tip

# Cover Your Mouth Using Your Elbow

### Why?

When you sneeze, droplets which carry germs are shot out of your mouth. Some have been measured flying 100 miles per hour. By covering your mouth and nose when you sneeze, you keep from spreading germs.

#### When?

You should do this any time you sneeze but especially if you are or have recently been sick. This helps keep those around you safe.

#### How?

After sneezing into your elbow be sure to wash up using soap and water or hand sanitizer.
