Future 4-H Dinosaur Seekers!

Get ready for a dinosaur adventure at the Southern Indiana 4-H Camp. Camp will be held May 30th-June 1st! 4-H members in grades 3-8 are invited to join this dinosaur experience for a fabulous camping excursion. Camp will be at Country Lake Retreat Center in Clark County. Check-in is Friday, May 30th from 9am-10am and pick up is at Noon on Sunday, June 1st. With a group of twelve counties camping together, you're sure to make new friends. Invite your friends to join us. Be sure to let them know they must officially join 4-H in order to register for camp! Our Dinosaur Camp Theme will be a lot of fun.

The total cost of camp is \$215. Our county is able to offer this at a 50% discounted rate of \$107.50 for our members. To receive this discounted rate, you MUST enter our coupon code (PZNVHW) in your event registration at checkout. The registration fee includes all activity and class supplies, buffet meals, snacks, and a 4-H Camp t-shirt. The prehistoric dinosaur location we will be staying does not allow outside food, so please do not bring personal snacks or drinks to camp. No worries my paleontologist, snacks are included in the price of camp. There's no need to bring any money to camp.

Dinosaur Adventure Awaits! There's limited space at 4-H Camp so get signed up quickly! All 4-H Camp registrations are being submitted through 4HOnline under the event name **Southern Indiana 4-H Camp**. Lawrence County will be listed as the registration county. (That is the county that created the event and not the county you are a 4-H member in.) Visit https://4honline.com to register. Instructions for how to register for camp are included. Payment can be made via check and turned in to the Purdue Extension Office or online with credit card. Your registration is due in 4HOnline by May 1, 2025. Health forms must be completed via 4HOnline. Changes can be presented during check-in at camp.

Once you have enrolled in camp, be on the lookout after May 10th for a confirmation letter, including information about what to bring to camp. All good dinosaur seekers will want to be prepared for this adventure including canoeing, fishing, swimming in the lake or pool, crafts, recreation, and special classes. Campers get to choose the classes they want to take at 4-H Camp. Be sure to enter your class choices in 4HOnline. Class choices will be on first come, first serve basis, so be sure to register ASAP to get the classes you want! We will do our best to accommodate all of your class choices, but you might be added to a class you did not choose. What a great way to learn something new!
