Embryology: The Study of Life

With this program, I bring an incubator and chicken eggs to your classroom to hatch. The eggs take 21 days to hatch. I come beforehand to set up the incubator and read a story about the process. I can also take the chicks after they hatch or you can give them away.



Soybean Science:


