News You Need to Know: All 4-H Families-

Enrollment Opens October 1!

- Indiana 4-H program enrollments <u>will open on October 1, 2024 and will</u> end on May 15, 2025.
- You will use the <u>v2.4honline.com</u> website to re-enroll. *Please carefully read through the questions when re-enrolling, 4-H Online has been updated!*
- Current 4-H/Mini 4-H members **must use the email and password** that was used when you first created your family profile. If you do not know what email you used, call our office and we will be glad to assist you.
- **4-H members, regardless of age, must enroll as "Youth".** This is true even for our older members who are, or may soon be, 18 years of age.
- **Do NOT create a new Family Profile!** Creating a new profile will result in slowing your enrollment process. We must delete the second profile you created and you will then have to re-enroll under your established profile.
- **Do you need to add a family member to 4-HOnline?** Be sure to add them to your current Family Profile. Do NOT create a new Family Profile!
 - ⇒ PRO TIP: If you have moved recently, please go into your family account and update the address under 'Member List', and under the individuals profile. If the address is not the same in both places, you may not receive important information sent out by our office!
- ALL 4-H members and Mini 4-H members, and Adult Volunteers MUST re-enroll each year!
- You can also follow us on Facebook at Shelby County, IN 4-H to keep up with the latest news.
- **Poinsettia sales have begun!** Proceeds benefit all 4-H programs. Orders will be filled on a first come-first served basis and may be called in to our office. Plants come in red, white, pink, shimmer surprise and ice crystals and cost \$10 each. Plant pick up day is December 3, 2024 between 12 noon and 5 p.m. at the Extension Office. - **Shooting Sports orientation meeting** will be held on December 3, 2024 in Brinson Hall at 7 p.m. on the Shelby County Fairgrounds. All members interested in the 2025 4-H Shooting Sports program are encouraged to attend with their parents.

4-H Livestock/ Animal Exhibitors-

- **PLANNING AHEAD:** keep in mind enrollment of 4-H animals will again be done through the 4-H Online website. The deadline is May 15. **All lease forms, auction forms and pen reservations are due May 15 to the Extension Office as well!**
 - ⇒ 2024 Animal Ownership Policy: "Dairy cows (as long as the animal is being shown by same 4-Her from 2020 and forward) and heifers, horses, ponies, alpacas and llamas may be leased, subject to approval of both the county 4-H dairy, horse and pony or llama committee and the respective County Extension Educator. 4-H animals (horse and pony, dairy, alpacas and llamas) are only eligible to be leased by a single 4-H member in a 4-H program year. COUNTY ONLY <u>All other species may be leased, but not shown at the state fair</u>, subject to approval of the livestock superintendents. These leased animals are not eligible to sell in the Livestock Auction. The lease agreement forms are due in the Shelby County Extension Office by May 15th." page 175 of 2024 Shelby County Handbook.
- This enrollment allows the animal to be identified as an official 4-H animal that can exhibit at our county show, 4-H fun shows, area shows and the Indiana State Fair. The following species must enroll by May 15 through v2.4honline.com
 - \Rightarrow Horse & Pony
 - \Rightarrow Cattle (beef & dairy)
 - ⇒ Goats
 - \Rightarrow Llamas
 - \Rightarrow Sheep
 - \Rightarrow Swine



- All animal lease forms must be turned in to the Extension Office by May 15!
- **Poultry Workshop November 14, 2024 from 5-7p.m.**: This workshop will include an introduction to the project, insight on how to select a bird for show, feeding and caring, and a guest speaker!



Mini 4-H Members-

- Mini 4-H enrollments for 2024-2025 will start on October 1, 2024 at v2.4honline.com. You must reenroll each year. The 2024-2025 Mini 4-H enrollment fee is \$5 per child. This fee includes access to Mini 4-H manuals and workshops. Please enroll under the same profile you used last year. Duplicate profiles must be deleted and will result in enrollment delays.

- What is RT2? The primary purpose of RT2 is to promote reading, good nutrition, and agriculture awareness among preschool and early elementary aged children. RT2 encourages parents and others to take time out of their busy day to enhance a child's learning experience.
- Who is it for? K-2 in Shelby County Mini 4-H
- Is there a cost? No! Youth participating in RT2 just have to be enrolled in Shelby County Mini 4-H for 2024-2025 program year.

Adult Volunteers-

*Changes for this year (4-H Online)

- New State update allowing volunteers to apply for volunteer with 4-H Online rather than in paper form
- Simplified training for returning volunteers (two trainings online)
- Volunteers, please re-enroll by **January 15, 2025**. This process needs to be completed sooner rather than later!
- Clubs that do not complete the necessary (annual) financial management forms are at risk of their club bring *dissolved* the following year.
- Encourage parents who assist with club meetings, workshops, and fair to become a volunteer
- Volunteer Update & Training will be held on October 26, 2024 in Brinson Hall.
 - ⇒ The volunteer **update** portion of the meeting (business) will take roughly one hour and begin at 9a.m.
 - ⇒ The volunteer **training** portion of the meeting (4-H Online) will take roughly one hour and will follow directly after the business portion of the meeting.

Becoming a NEW Adult Volunteer-




excellent role models for our members. As a result, we require anyone interested in volunteering with our program to go through the Approved 4-H Volunteer Process.
