





Are you currently a volunteer, but you would like to add and/or change your volunteer duties?



SCHOLARSHIPS

Indiana 4-H has scholarship opportunities for members in grades 10 -12. Check them out on the Indiana 4-H page under scholarships. The due dates will arrive sooner than expected, so definitely consider getting started!

Remember that some local scholarships have requirements for submitting transcripts once in college. Don't miss out by forgetting to complete this task!



4-H ENROLLMENT



When participating in Indiana 4-H as a member or a volunteer, one must be officially enrolled in the program through 4-H Online! This means individuals making programmatic decisions, meeting with youth, or participating in 4-H events should be enrolled as a member or volunteer.

Remember that one is <u>not</u> automatically a member or volunteer simply by submitting their enrollment in 4-H Online! The enrollment must be approved by 4-H staff in the system.



RULE CHANGES

The 2nd reading and vote for the suggest rule changes for the 2025-2026 Steuben County 4-H year will take place at the October 20th Fair Board meeting at 7pm.

Remember that for the rule change to be considered, the individual or a like minded representative that submitted the rule change suggestion must be present!

The Steuben County 4-H Fair Board meetings are open to the public. Volunteers and parents/guardians are encouraged to attend to be involved in discussions.

When you visit the Steuben County Extension Office, you will now be greeted with a new, but potentially familiar face! Introducing our new office secretary, Amanda Quaderer!




Amanda grew up in the area and is very fond of Steuben County.
