We have concluded another year of **Bi-State conferences** at the Beef House near Covington. This year's offerings included the Crops Conference held on December 10th, as well as our annual Gardening Conference (January 14th) and Homesteading Conference (February 18th).

We are once again offering a statewide on-line **Master Gardener intern training** that runs for 14 weeks from February 5th to May 6th. On Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:30 pm participants receive in-depth training on a gardening topic presented by a statewide expert. Also, each week prior to this statewide webinar, we meet at 5:30 pm via Zoom for our Local Connection that this year includes 15 local Master Gardener trainees. During this Local Connection the Purdue Extension Ag & Natural Resources educators from Warren, Fountain and Montgomery counties lead conversations on the previous week's statewide topic as well as other gardening topics of interest to the group members.

We are nearing the completion of a series of **pesticide applicator recertification (PARP) meetings** that began with the Bi-State Crops Conference on December 10th at the Beef House and is concluding with morning PARPs in Benton (February 12th), Warren (March 26th), and Fountain (March 7th) Counties.

Purdue Extension crop specialists and county ag educators are once again looking to help farmers who are doing **on-farm trials** to compare various products and practices. If you are planning to compare fertilizer practices, seeding populations, test the efficacy of a biological product or any number of other on-farm trials then we would like to offer assistance. This may be help with planning and setting up the trial, generation of in-season crop health maps using a drone flight, scouting, or tissue and/or soil testing. On February 25th, the Ag and Natural Resources educators from Warren and surrounding counties offered a **pruning workshop** at the Purdue Meig's Farm south of Lafayette. Considering it was late February, the sunny 50 degree weather was nearly perfect for the 45 attendees who learned about pruning and care of apples, pears, grapevines and brambles. This workshop is hand-on with those attending encourage to bring their loppers and pruners and join in on the fun of pruning.
