Hello Warrick County 4-H Member!

I would like to invite you to enter Warrick County's Fair Royalty Contest, formerly known as the Warrick County Queen Contest. According to 2024-2025 4-H enrollment, you will be at least 16 years of age or older by June 1, 2025. The Warrick County Royalty Contest will take place on **Saturday**, **July 12**, **2025**, **at 7:00PM**.

To enter the contest, please complete the enclosed application and return it to the Purdue Extension Office on or before May 2, 2025, by 4:00PM. The application MUST be accompanied with a wallet sized photo of yourself and \$15.00 registration fee. During Warrick County 4-H Fair week, your photo and biography will be displayed in the Exhibit Building as well as being published in the local newspaper. The contest judges will receive a copy of the front page of your application ONLY so be sure to list your best accomplishments first. This will ensure that the judges read what you really want them to know about you. Remember to be neat and detailed when completing the application. Typing is preferred. The application can also be downloaded from the Purdue Extension-Warrick County website at: https://extension.purdue.edu/county/warrick. Applications are due on or before May 2, 2025, by 4:00PM.

As a contestant, you will be required to attend the following workshops in preparation for the contest.

May 27 th : 5:30 PM	Tuesday – Initial Meeting/Parent Meeting. A parent or guardian must attend this meeting with
	candidate to go over general information and expectations.
June 3rd: 5:00 PM	Tuesday – Stage practice and walking techniques.
June 10th: 5:00 PM	Tuesday – Stage practice and interview techniques.
June 17th: 5:00 PM	Tuesday – Stage practice and speech workshop.
June 24th: 6:00 PM	Tuesday – Interview and speech workshop.
June 29th: 2:00 PM	Sunday – Stage Set-up and Runway Practice
July 8th: 5:00 PM	Tuesday Dress Rehearsal and Mock Interviews with guest judges.
July 12th TBA	Saturday – Interviews (MANDATORY)
July 12th TBA	Saturday – Contest check in time for evening
July 12th: 7:00 PM	Saturday – Contest Begins

Please bring a pair of high heeled pumps to every workshop! All contest attire must be pre-approved by the Fair Royalty Contest Committee, so please bring those clothing options to the workshops.

The winner of the Warrick County Fair Royalty Contest, if eligible (18 years or older by June 1, 2025), will represent Warrick County in January 2026 at the Indiana State Fair Contest in Indianapolis.

I hope that this contest event perks your interest and you will choose to make the Warrick County 4-H Fair an even more memorable experience by entering as a contestant in the Fair Royalty Contest! I am sure that you will find this experience to be exciting and enjoyable! I look forward to seeing your name on the list of 2025 contestants.
