



Mini Horse
FairEntry

1. Enroll in the Mini Horse Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
4. Mini 4-H members must work with their parent/guardian to fill out the Mini 4-H Horse and Pony Lead Worksheet supplied by the extension office
 - a. Worksheet instructions: Attend 3 separate White County 4-H Horse and Pony Workshops. Speak with at least one Horse and Pony member and have them help you answer the questions in the worksheet.
5. Doing a Mini 4-H Horse and Pony Lead Worksheet qualifies you, if you choose, to show a 4-H member's horse in a Mini 4-H Showmanship class. Approved headgear must be worn.
6. Min 4-H Member will use a separate lead rope. The horse will also be led by an adult using another lead rope.



Mini Poultry

1. Enroll in the Mini Poultry Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form in Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
4. Wearing long sleeves is recommended when handling poultry.



Mini Sheep

1. Enroll in the Mini Sheep Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form in fairentry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.



Mini Swine

1. Enroll in the Mini Swine Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form in fairentry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.

When signing up in Fair Entry a parent or Guardian **MUST** digitally sign a Mini 4-H Liability Re-lease Form and submit to the Extension Office by July 1st Deadline.



**Mini Beef
FairEntry
Class # 600853**

1. Enroll in the Mini Beef Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Animal weight restrictions—Please see General Rules #3 & #4 regarding member working with animals under 300 lbs. and over 300 lbs.
4. Mini 4-H member must work with a beef animal PRIOR to fair. Proof of practice with the animal & Mini Beef Worksheet due by July 10th. Forms available at the Extension Office. Contact a Beef Committee member if you need assistance in finding a family to work with.
5. Show Day—Participants must wear long pants with close-toed shoes (leather shoes or heavy boots). Open-toed/sandals are NOT allowed.
6. Participants will use animals provided by 4-H members, they will not bring their own.
7. Beef Mini Lead will follow Beef Showmanship on Sunday morning at the fair.



**Mini Rabbit
FairEntry
Class # 600855**

1. Enroll in the Mini Rabbit Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
4. Rabbit Mini Lead class will be held at 2 PM, Sunday of the fair at the Rabbit Barn.
5. A rabbit will be provided for all Mini 4-H member participating.

General Rules

- 1) **Members will exhibit fellow 4-H member's animal. They WILL NOT bring their own animal to the fair. Members and their families will be responsible for finding a 4-H member who will allow them to borrow an animal for Mini Lead. If assistance is needed with this, please reach out to a member of the livestock barn committee prior to date of show.**
- 2) **Parent/Guardian of the mini member MUST complete a Mini 4-H Liability Release Form and submit by July 1st. Mini members will be allowed to show, work with, or care for animals projects AFTER their parent/guardian has signed a liability release form.**
- 3) **Mini members may independently show, work with, or care for animals that weigh 300 pounds or less.**
- 4) **Mini members may only show, work with, or care for animals over 300 pounds when they are assisted by a parent, legal guardian, or another adult designated in writing by parent or legal guardian. (Adult has control of the animal at all times.)**
- 5) **If the guidelines stated in this policy are not followed for a particular event or activity, then such event or activity shall not be considered to be a 4-H event or activity and shall not be under the auspices of Extension 4-H educators or covered by Purdue University.**
- 6) **All Mini Lead classes will be listed in the 4-H Fair Schedule, released in June.**

**Mini Goat

Class # 600851**

1. Enroll in the Mini Goat Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in the Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes. No sandals or open-toed.
4. All Mini participants will be assisted by a current goat project member. Goats will be provided.
5. Goat Lead Class will be held between Pygmy and Meat Goat Shows on Wednesday of the fair.



**Mini Female
Dairy
FairEntry
Class # 600852**

1. Enroll in the Mini Female Dairy Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in Fair Entry by July 1st.
3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes, preferably leather shoes or heavy boots. Open-toed or sandals are NOT allowed.
4. Participants will use 4-H member's animals. Participants will not bring their own.
5. Inexperienced Mini participants will have other 4-H Dairy members and/or arena workers available to assist them with the animal as needed.
6. Mini Lead will follow Female Dairy Showmanship.
