Hello 4-H Families,

The White County 4-H program uses the FairEntry system for registering all projects to be exhibited at the fair, checking in projects, recording results, and communicating that information to the Indiana State Fair. All projects (animal and building projects) will be registered prior to the White County 4-H Fair through this online program. This program is paired with the 4-H Online program and is used throughout Indiana. All 4-H projects (building & livestock) must be registered in the FairEntry system by **Monday**, **July 1st.**

Following are some key details about this process:

- Complete your fair entry between June 1st and July 1st
- Do not use Internet Explorer as your web browser. The 2 recommended browsers for FairEntry are either Google Chrome or FireFox. Mobile devices are also supported.
- 4-H members will pre-register each project one at a time. Do NOT hit the submit button until
 you ensure that all projects are entered and project information is correct.
- You will use your 4-H Online username and password to login to FairEntry.
- Please see the "Step by Step Guide for Entering Exhibits in FairEntry System" included. This
 guide should help with 4-Hers registering all projects.
- Mini 4-H members will be required to upload a copy or photo of completed project record sheet when they register for each particular project. Do not bring project record sheets to check-in.
- It is strongly encouraged that 4-H members upload a copy or photo of completed project record sheet when they register for projects, regardless of if they do not wish to participate in the virtual fair option.
- We can make changes, so please do not be afraid that you will be locked into a class when registering your projects.
- There is no additional fee for registering projects in FairEntry.
- Please, do not wait until the last minute to complete this process!
- Animal projects not enrolled in FairEntry by JULY 1ST will be eligible for exhibition only.
 However, you are still eligible to participate in Showmanship and exhibit these projects at the
 Indiana State Fair (per State Fair rules). You will NOT be eligible to participate in the White
 County 4-H Fair Auction. There are no longer late entry fees.
