

FASHION REVUE GUIDELINES FOR DIGITAL SHOWCASE



THE VIDEO MUST...

- Between 60 and 90 seconds
- Be filmed HORIZONTALLY.
- Must be shot continuously. No editing, starting, or stopping.
- Have no ZOOMING



EXHIBITOR REFERENCE SHEET

- Use a 8 x 10 piece of white paper
- Legibly put the following information:
 - Name
 - Project
 - Date Video Filmed



VIDEO TIPS

- Take videos during daylight. Avoid direct sunlight in videos.
- No vulgar language.
- Videographer may make reference to time.
- You may have friend or family read emcee card.
- Remember to upload a copy of your emcee card for the judge to read.
- PRACTICE!



RECORDING BREAKDOWN

- 5 second shot of the 4-H member holding their exhibitor reference sheet. 4-H members face should be showing.
- Videographer should stand in one place as 4-H member walks around displaying all angles of their outfit.
- 4-H member should hold a front, back, and side pose for 10-15 seconds each.
- A family member or friend may read the emcee card during the video.
