- 1. To encourage boys and girls to sew items they enjoy.
- 2. To have fun creating sewn articles.
- 3. To develop judgment in planning and selecting articles, which enhances appearance; is suitable for the age and intended use of the 4-H'er.
- 4. To choose fabric compatible with the pattern.

WHAT YOU WILL DO

- 1. Make at least one sewn item you would like for yourself or for someone else. Choose any sewn item you would like to make.
- 2. Be able to explain how you would care for this item. Wash and dry, drip dry, self-service dry clean or commercial dry clean.

WHAT YOU WILL EXHIBIT

1. The sewn item you made.

OTHER INFORMATION YOU WILL NEED TO KNOW

- 1. This is a Bartholomew County 4-H Project. There is no exhibit at the State Fair.
- 2. You will participate in the Community Fashion Revue.
- 3. You will be asked to model the sewn item for the Community Fashion Revue Judge who will give you helpful information on the following:
 - a. Does the garment fit?
 - b. Is the fabric compatible with the pattern used?
 - c. Is the item neat and well pressed?
 - d. Is the garment suitable for the person wearing it?
- 4. Your sewn item will be exhibited at the 4-H Fair and an appropriate "Sewing for Fun" ribbon will be awarded.
- 5. You may participate in the "Sewing for Fun" class at the County Fashion Revue. Participation ribbons will be awarded. No Champion will be selected. There will be no State Dress Revue entry in this category.
