In order for a Horse & Pony member to be eligible to show in the Boone County Versatility Sweepstakes, he/she must place in the top 30% of two (2) performance classes in the Horse & Pony show at the County Fair.

- Qualifying classes would not include showmanship, roadster, driving, costume, halter, or the championship classes.
- Points will be awarded to the rider; however, the horse to be shown in the Versatility Sweepstakes class must have met the qualifications in at least one (1) qualifying class.
- Exhibitors who qualify for the Versatility Sweepstakes must compete in at least one (1) English performance class, one (1) Western performance class, and at least one (1) gaming class during the County Fair.
- A disqualification (DQ) in any qualifying class does not count as participation in that class.
- Tie breakers for the Versatility Sweepstakes class are: (1) Most blue ribbons. (2) Most red ribbons. (3) Placed in most classes. (4) Tie-breakers class. (The tie-breakers class is randomly drawn by the Versatility chairperson or judge prior to the beginning of the Versatility Sweepstakes class.)

- Each Versatility competitor may have up to two (2) assistants to assist with tack and clothing changes.
- Opportunity for tack changes will take place after each class and shall last five (5) minutes. Contestants shall not receive any coaching once the Versatility Sweepstakes has begun.
- Once the competitor has entered the arena for the Versatility Sweepstakes, they will not be dismissed until the end of the event.
- Leaving the arena (other than exiting to the make-up arena for gaming classes) will result in disqualification from the event.
- A 4-H Horse & Pony member can win the Versatility Sweepstakes two (2) times in their 4-H career.
- A child may win only one (1) time as a Beginner or Intermediate (3rd-8th grades). If the child has not won the Versatility Sweepstakes as a Beginner or Intermediate (3rd-8th grades), he/she may win two (2) times as a Senior (9th-12th grades) proveded he/she is exhibiting a different animal each time.
- A 4-H Horse & Pony member that has won as a Beginner or Intermediate (3rd-8th grades) may use the same horse/pony to participate/win as a Senior exhibitor (9th-12th grades).
