2021 4-H Fair

Indiana 4-H intends to hold face-to-face county fairs in 2021. Last year, we demonstrated our ability to safely conduct in-person fair with appropriate guidelines to keep everyone safe. After guidance and information is shared to us from the State 4-H office, we will then share that information with you all.



4-H members exhibiting beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry ,and rabbits **MUST** be certified to exhibit at the county and state fair. This is an annual education program that can be completed either in-person (\$3) or online modules (\$12). In-person training dates will be released in the next couple of weeks.
