GENERAL RULES

- Entries are open to everyone (need not be Fountain County resident). Exhibit must be work of the exhibitor.
- 2. All exhibits must have been made since the last 4-H Fair except quilts (made within last two years, and not previously exhibited at the Fountain County Fair).
- 3. Flowers and vegetables should come from the exhibitor's own garden.
- 4. Recipe must accompany all Culinary Arts entries .
- 5. A fee of \$3 per entry will be charged, up to 5 entries (\$15). Unlimited entries may be made after the cap of \$15 has been reached. Only one entry may be made in each class.
- Exhibits will be entered on Saturday, July 10th between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. Judging will begin at 11:30. Suggestion: Exhibitors entering several projects can save time at check-in by bringing address labels to place on tags.
- Exhibits will be released on Thursday, July 15th between 8:00 a.m.—1:00 p.m. Committee is not responsible for items left after the release hours.
- A sample of baked goods will be taken for exhibit, and the remainder will be auctioned on Saturday, July 10th at 6:00 p.m. Proceeds will be used to help pay for Open Class expenses and for scholarships.
- 9. There will be a first, second, and third place winner in each class, with a grand champion and reserve grand champion selected in each division.
- 10. Monetary gifts will be awarded in the following amounts: \$10 to the grand champion in each division and \$5 to the reserve grand champion in each division.

- 11. Fragile items and quilts will be displayed in as safe a manner as possible. Committee is not responsible for any loss or damage.
- 12. Participants are welcome to watch the open judging. The judges may be asked to make verbal comments (no scorecards).
- 13. Entries will not be accepted for display only.
- 14. Please adhere to the rules!

A newspaper photograph of the division grand champion winners will be taken immediately after the judging, in the Open Class area.
