

## **Hendricks County 4-H Flower Sales**

It is time again for the <u>4-H Flower Sales!</u> 4-H Flower sales are the most important fundraiser. The money raised with this sale supports the Hendricks County 4-H Program, 4-H Youth Council and local 4-H clubs! We need your help as 4-H members in selling these plants to your family, friends and the general public.

Enclosed, you will find a 4-H Flower Flyer, a Flower Money Envelope, and a 4-H Flower Order Form. The money you collect can be stored in the Flower Money envelope enclosed with this letter. Once you have collected your orders, please turn in your orders as designated by **your 4-H Club Leader**. We would like you to have your orders turned into your club leader no later than <u>March 12th</u>; however, some clubs may request an earlier deadline. *Talk with your Club Leader to learn when your order is due.* It is critical that you turn in your order to your leader on time. *Orders not turned in on time will not be guaranteed flowers.* Don't know your club leader? Contact the Extension Office and we will get you connected!

For details on money collection and plant pick-ups, please refer to your 4-H Club Leader. Checks can be made payable to the <u>Hendricks County 4-H Youth Council</u>. Make sure you have the correct details from your club such as pick-up times and order due dates. In addition, please have all your money returned to your club leader by your club designated due date. Several clubs have money due at time of order while others prefer at time of flower pick up. *Clubs will receive 10% of what their club members sell!* Plus, for every \$100 of flowers *you* sell, *you* will receive \$5 in Café bucks to spend at the 4-H Keystone Café during the fair!

4-H Flowers will be available for pick-up on May 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> from your club's designated pick-up site. <u>You need to talk</u> with your club leader to find out the official time, date, and location for your flower pick up! Most clubs will have their orders picked up at the Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds. Open sales for any leftover flowers will be Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> from 8-10 a.m. at the Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds.

Our traditional seed geraniums will be sold at \$2.50 each and will be available in **RED** or **HOT PINK**. We will also be selling **PURPLE** and **WHITE** wave petunias. These will be \$5.00 per plant. All flowers will be sold until we sell out! Be sure to check out the enclosed flyer for more information. We are using the same grower as last year - Sugar Grove Greenhouse – located right here in Hendricks County! We are excited about the quality of product and great customer service we have received from this locally owned business.

PLEASE be sure to keep a copy of your order form as it will have the information of everyone who bought flowers from you!! Club Leaders just need TOTAL numbers from you.
