2021 Beef Quality Assurance Trainings


<u>WHY:</u> Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) training and certification is now required for beef producers selling "fed cattle" (finished beef steers and heifers coming out of a feedlot) that ultimately are processed by many of today's major packers. BQA certification is good for 3 years and the program is free to producers either in the face-to-face or on-line formats.
