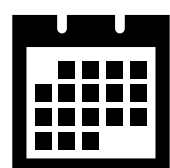
## WHY YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

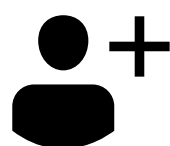
