



#### Beyond the Barn: Ag Career Tours



#### Canvas Painting Night - February 13




# Beyond the Barn: Ag Career Tours Miller Poultry Tour - April 2, 2025

### Bird Flu is Nearby: Be Ready!

If you have a hobby poultry flock, consider signing up for Indiana Board of Animal Health Alerts! These alerts are very helpful with the Highly Pathogenetic Avian Influenzas (HPAI) creeping around the area. How to sign up?

First, if you do not have a Premise ID for your flock, sign up here: <a href="https://www.in.gov/boah/traceability-and-premise-id/">https://www.in.gov/boah/traceability-and-premise-id/</a>. This will send you an alert when new outbreaks are announced.

### **Produce Grower Programs for Winter 2025**

Two meetings are scheduled for area produce and fruit growers in February.

Because we have seen an uptick in serious disease issues in the region, we will be hosting a **Disease**Control Program on Feb 17 from 6 to 9 pm at the

Elkhart County Fairgrounds. Growers will learn about techniques to limit disease issues both before and after planting the crop. PARP credit will be available for those with a Private Pesticide License.

The second meeting on Feb. 25 is the Produce Safety Alliance Training. Also known as FSMA (pronounced FIZ-ma) this is important if you sell produce to the **public.** If you have taken the training before, you may want to attend because the rule as been updated. The food safety laws require growers to follow specific steps, including the ability to trace produce back to the farm of origin. The training includes worker safety, using manure and compost around vegetables, sanitation, water use for both irrigation and postharvest. The cost is free! Normally it is \$125/person, however, grant funding is paying for the training. Locally it will be held at the David Fry farm southeast of Lagrange from noon until about 8 pm. Call our office at 260-499-6334 for more info and to make a reservation.
