ALL Rabbit entries need to be included on this form including breed/fur class rabbits, meat classes, and hopping/agility rabbits. **ALL** possibly County Born and Bred entries must be indicated on this form. All Animals must be permanently Tattooed in the Left ear and listed. Each exhibitor may exhibit one entry in each category and no more than 15 in the Breed/Fur Class category. Age is the age on the day of the show.

Meat Definitions: Meat Pen and Single Fryers: to be no older than 70 days/10 weeks at check-in at the fair and weigh 3.5-5.5 pounds. Roaster: one rabbit between 5-8 pounds on check-in day and be under 6 months old. Stewer: one rabbit 8 pounds or more at check-in and over 6 months of age .
