Pre-Fair Cleanup:

Saturday, June 28th starting at 7 a.m.: Rousing Rookies and Country Bumpkins

If you are a member of these clubs, you are responsible for helping cleanup the Exhibit Building. Please bring cleaning supplies such as window cleaner, paper towels, trash bags, water buckets, rags, brooms, squeegees. (This is early due to the 4th of July holiday).

Saturday, July 12th at 7 a.m.: all remaining clubs

If your club did not help on June 28th, then you are responsible for helping cleanup the remainder of the fairgrounds. Areas to be cleaned include: around all the buildings on the fairgrounds and livestock barns. Livestock exhibitors are expected to help in the barns. Please bring the following tools to help: hammers, saws, nails, wire cutters, trash bags, gloves, safety glasses, rakes, water buckets, rags, shovels, wheel barrows, garden hoses, pruners, drills, extension cords, dust pans, brooms.

We ask that all others wait outside or at the entrance so we have enough room for all the youth to have a seat and less noise for the judging that is going on.

If you have other projects to be turned in, you can turn them in between 4-6 p.m. through the man door that faces the PCCEC. Be sure to pick up your 4-H t-shirt outside that door.

Project Check out in the Exhibit Building

Thursday, July 17th from 8-10 p.m. and Friday following the conclusion of the auction approximately 12-1 p.m. Premium money will be available to pick up in the Exhibit Building during those times. Non-perishable State Fair selected projects can stay so that they can be transported to the State Fair later in July. IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP PROJECTS BY JULY 18th AT 1PM, THEY WILL BE THROWN AWAY. Premium money will not be available after 1 PM.

(Open Class will have project check out on Thursday from 6-7 p.m. The building will be closed at this time. **NO 4-H EXHIBITS WILL BE RELEASED AT THAT TIME!)**

Fair Cleanup

After the Livestock Auction on Friday, July 18 all barns and livestock arena will be cleaned up. The Exhibit Building will be cleaned up during the 2nd opportunity to check-out projects. The majority of the cleanup will be done on Friday. There may be a need for additional help on Saturday. All 4-H families are expected to help.

FAIR ENTRY

Just like last year, 4-H'ers added projects on 4-H Online by May 15. Then they logged onto Fair Entry to indicate exactly what projects they are bringing to the Fair by June 15. <u>If you did not complete Fair Entry you will not have project tags ready at check-in and will need to find an Extension Office staff member to assist you when available.</u>

Limited number of Electric project supplies are available to purchase, a check payment to the Purdue CES Ed Fund is preferred.




