**4-H Online- deadline to sign up for projects is May 15th**

**Fair Entry: Submit entries by June 15<sup>th</sup>. All 4-H'ers are required to complete.**

**Pre-Fair Cleanup:**

**Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup> starting at 7 a.m. : Rousing Rookies and Country Bumpkins**

If you are a member of these clubs, you are responsible for helping cleanup the Exhibit Building. Please bring cleaning supplies such as window cleaner, paper towels, trash bags, water buckets, rags, brooms, squeegees. (This is early due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday).

### **Saturday, July 12<sup>th</sup> at 7 a.m. : all remaining clubs**

If your club did not help on June 28<sup>th</sup>, then you are responsible for helping cleanup the remainder of the fairgrounds. Areas to be cleaned include: around all the buildings on the fairgrounds and livestock barns. Livestock exhibitors are expected to help in the barns. Please bring the following tools to help: hammers, saws, nails, wire cutters, trash bags, gloves, safety glasses, rakes, water buckets, rags, shovels, wheel barrows, garden hoses, pruners, drills extension cords, dust pans, brooms.

## **Project Check In**

### **Tuesday, July 8<sup>th</sup> 4-6 p.m.**

Static projects are checked in at the Exhibit Building: aerospace, americana, animal posters, arts & crafts, beekeeping, child development, collections, communications (creative writing), computer, electric, entomology, family camping, forestry, genealogy, geology, health, home environment, photography, recycling, scrapbooking, small engines, soil & water science, sportfishing, sports, tractor poster, travelogue, veterinary science, weather, wildlife, woodworking, secretary books, ten year/last year member boards.

**\*\*Eggs will only be checked in at the Poultry Show on Tuesday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 a.m.**

**Community judging** in the exhibit building on July 8<sup>th</sup> will include: construction toys, consumer clothing, farm scene, models, pet pals, sewing. 4-Her's will be asked to sign up on using sign up genius for a time slot. We hope that this will help to keep things running smoothly. Each exhibitor will be allotted maximum amount of time and then the judge will have time to write comments and make decisions between exhibitors. We will have a sign up sheet coming out after Fair Entry closes and we have definite numbers. Should you not sign up for a spot, you will go at the very end after everyone else is done.

Club banners and displays need to be turned in on July 8th.

If you are unable to make check-in, please reach out. We are willing to work with you.

### **Sunday, July 15<sup>th</sup> 12 - 2 p.m.**

**Community Center Check in** cake decorating, cupcake decorating, foods, food preservation, and flowers. Projects will be community judged in the PCCEC from 12 - 2 p.m.

Food will be donated for the 4-H Food Auction on Monday, July 16th.

**Exhibit Building check in** corn production, corn science, soybean production, soybean science and garden from 12 - 2 p.m.

## **Check Out**

### **Project Check out in the Exhibit Building**

Thursday, July 17<sup>th</sup> from 8-10 p.m. and Friday following the conclusion of the auction approximately 12-1 p.m. Premium money will be available to pick up in the Exhibit Building during those times. Non-perishable State Fair selected projects can stay so that they can be transported to the State Fair later in July. IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP PROJECTS BY JULY 18<sup>th</sup> AT 1PM, THEY WILL BE THROWN AWAY. Premium money will not be available after 1 PM.

(Open Class will have project check out on Thursday from 6-7 p.m. The building will be closed at this time. NO 4-H EXHIBITS WILL BE RELEASED AT THAT TIME!)

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

# Indiana Livestock Quality Training

We have held two livestock training classes so far, thank you very much for all that have completed this training either in person or online. The final in person class will be held on May 13<sup>th</sup>, this will be paid for by the 4-H Council. The training will be held at the Posey County Community and Events Center (PCCEC). If you can't attend this event, you will need to go to a class in a different county or take the training online. This will not be provided by the 4-H Council though.

**Livestock Superintendents**- After the May 13<sup>th</sup> training at 6 p.m., there will be a training for you on Fair Entry by 4-H Educator, Lauren from Dubois County. She will be there for however long to help answer all of your questions! She will not be available the week of our fair and it's very important for you to attend this training! There won't be the assistance the week of the fair like you've had in the past.

## Animal ID -Tagging

All beef, dairy, meat goat, sheep and swine exhibitors are required to correctly enter animal tag ID's into 4-H Online. You will not be allowed to enter 0's into the tag entry on 4-H Online.

This year you will fill out a Google Document to reserve tags. Then we will email you back once the tags are ready to pick up. At this time, there will be no tagging day. Not sure what you need? This document is very detailed in helping you select your answers. Please do not wait until the last minute. Our office needs a minimum of 48 hours to be able to pull tags. **We would appreciate the last day to request tags be May 9<sup>th</sup>. This way you can pick up tags by May 13<sup>th</sup> and get them in 4-H Online by May 15<sup>th</sup>. Please realize there are two of us working on all things extension in our office.**

## Premise ID

Registering your premises is done online, at no charge, and takes only about 5 minutes. Visit the Indiana State Board of Animal Health's (BOAH) website: [www.in.gov/boah](http://www.in.gov/boah) and click on "Premises

Registration”.

BOAH staff will issue a premise identification number (also known as a “premlD”) within three to five business days after the online form is submitted. If registering by mail with a paper form, allow ten business days for a premlD to be issued.

Do you need to verify your premises identification number? Contact BOAH at: 317-544-2400 or email [animalhealth@boah.in.gov](mailto:animalhealth@boah.in.gov). Be sure to note the name and premises’ physical address listed on the registration.

All Indiana premises associated with the purchase, sale and/or exhibition of cattle, swine, sheep, goats and farmed cervids must be registered by state law. Registration allows BOAH to be more effective tracing animal movements in a major animal health emergency investigation.

## 4-H Online Animal ID Family Sharing

Please note that you are only allowed to list siblings’ animals on your 4-H Online profile. You cannot list secondary family animals on your 4-H Online. This means you cannot list cousins’ animals on your profile. If you have any questions, please contact the Extension Office 812-838-1331.

## Official ID

An Official ID tag is imprinted with an “US shield”

Official ID tags include but not limited to Scrapie Tag, Flock ID, visual 840 Tags &/or 840 RFID Tags.

Official ID tags are permanent & tamper resistant.

It is a FELONY to remove an Official Identification!

## Animal ID Deadline

**All animal identification is to be submitted on 4-H Online by May 15. Animals not enrolled by this deadline cannot be exhibited at the county or state fair.**
