- The 4-H Court will consist of four individuals and the 4-H Royalty will consist of two individuals with the highest ranking scores from the application and interview.
- Names will <u>not</u> be associated with applications given to the 4-H Council Royalty Committee. Each applicant will be assigned a number by the Extension Office.
- Candidates must fill out the following application and submit it with a copy of their permanent 4-H record (Green Achievement Book) and a wallet-sized photo.
- Be in Grades 9-12.
- Have been in 4-H at least five years, including this year.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and of good moral character.
- Applicants must sign the 4-H Youth Behavioral Expectations form which requires you to comply with 4-H youth expectations such as being a good role model, mentoring other 4-H members, etc. If the Youth Behavioral Expectations standards are broken during a 4-H event or activity, the 4-H Royalty will be asked to step down from their role. If anyone who is part of Royalty does not uphold their Youth Behavioral Expectations, he/she will be required to meet with the 4-H Council Scholarship/Royalty committee to discuss actions and consequences.
- Applicants will participate in an interview by a panel of Royalty Judges. Interviews will
  be held in May. Please wear appropriate attire for interviews. Royalty Interview Judges
  will reside outside of Pulaski County. The panel will consist of those involved in business,
  education, finance, etc. Applications will be sent to the judges prior to the day of the
  interview.
- The Royalty and Court must agree to be available for presenting awards and representing the 4-H program at the fair and for other occasions throughout the year.
   Please make arrangements with your employer in advance so if you are chosen for this honor, you will be able to fulfill your duties.
- In the event you are selected, you will be expected to wear appropriate attire during the fair while wearing the Royalty and/or Court sash. This is a great honor to represent our county and state 4-H program.
- The Royalty and Court will receive various awards. You may only receive the honor of 4-H Royalty once and cannot reapply. However, 4-H Court members may reapply in subsequent years.
