- Mini 4-H is open to youth who are currently in **Kindergarten**, **first**, **or second grade** at the time of their enrollment on 4HOnline.
- Enroll in Mini 4-H through the 4HOnline website by January 15, https://in.4HOnline.com
- There is no state program fee or manual fee for Mini 4-H, a local club fee may apply.
- Each Mini 4-H member can enroll in up to 5 mini 4-H projects and is able to **exhibit 2 mini-projects** at the St. Joseph County 4-H Fair.
- All projects to be exhibited must be entered into Fairentry.com (https://stjoseph-in.fairentry.com) prior to check-in.
- All Mini 4-H projects are checked in on Monday or Tuesday of project turn-in week, one week before fair starts, in the 4-H Exhibit Hall of the Esther Singer Building. Enter Gate 2 off Ironwood Road.
- Your completed Mini 4-H project will receive a 4-H ribbon once it is exhibited at the 4-H Fair.

MODELS:

You will learn how to put together a snap type model kit requiring no glue. You may pick out a model boat, car, airplane or anything!

Exhibit Requirements: You will exhibit your finished snap type model at the 4-H Fair.

You may purchase ANY SNAP-TYPE MODEL KIT of your choosing. The model you pick may be a boat, car, airplane, or whatever you want. You are to put it together using no glue and finish it however you want.

Your Father or a friend can help you read the instructions and help you understand how it is to be put together. However, as a Mini 4-H'er, you are to complete the model kit by yourself.

REMEMBER:

- 1. CHOOSE A MODEL YOU LIKE.
- 2. PLASTIC SNAP-TYPE MODELS USUALLY HAVE MORE DETAIL.
- 3. DO NOT SPEND TOO MUCH FOR THE KIT.
- 4. MODELS MAY OR MAY NOT BE PAINTED.
- 5. MODELS MUST BE SNAP-TYPE.
- 6. SHOP AROUND!!

WHEN YOU HAVE YOUR KIT:

- 1. SELECT A PLACE TO WORK WHERE ALL THE PIECES CAN BE ARRANGED.
- 2. READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.
- 3. HAVE SOMEONE GIVE YOU ADVICE, BUT DO THE WORK YOURSELF.

Step-by-Step, as your directions state, put your model together. When you are through, put your model in a safe place so that no one will bother it and you can find it at 4-H Fair time. You may bring the box your model came in so you can put your model on top of the box at the 4-H Fair.

If you had fun putting your model together, why not build a second one? Choose the best one to exhibit at the 4-H Fair!!
