- Front Columns
 - **□**Year
 - Chronological order, 2008 on top
 - □Project
 - Division/Level
 - List level, division, or grade (go by what is in handbook)

- Number of Garments, Dishes, Articles, Animals
 - Include of all work required to complete the project
 - Manuals list sections completed
- Exhibit
 - Write what exactly is taken to fair



- Exhibits Placing
 - Local mock judging placing
 - County and State placing
- Record Grade
 - 4-H leader should write "Comp." for complete or "Inc." for incomplete and sign his/her initials for each project
