# SHOOTING SPORTS INSTRUCTOR TRAINING


The Fall 4-H Shooting Sports Instructor
Certification Workshop will be held **September**10-12, 2021, at Ross Camp in Tippecanoe
County. Registration for this workshop is now
open via the Indiana Hunter Education
Association website.

Each of the 6 4-H Shooting Sports disciplines is scheduled to be offered: Archery, Muzzleloader, Outdoor Skills, Pistol, Rifle, and Shotgun. The program will begin with registration at 6 p.m. on Friday, September 10, and conclude on Sunday, September 12, at approximately 4 p.m.
