4-H Fair Camping Rules

- 1. Overnight camping is being allowed to 4-H families during the Fair. Parking your camper in an East/West direction IS REQUIRED!
- An electric outlet will be assigned to you. First come, first serve.
 Each numbered spot CAN hold 2 hook-ups.
 There is only electric hook-up: No water hook-up or sewage dump is available.
- 3. Campers should display the camp permit number in a window/door of the camper so it's visible. It will have your arrival and departure dates.
- 4. Campers may utilize the area west of the 4-H Community Center.

 Campers are not to plug into the barns.
- 5. No open fires will be allowed. Protected grills are permitted. Alcohol is not allowed on the grounds-you could be asked to vacate the premises.
- 6. **Quiet time** at the 4-H Park camping area is between the hours of **11 pm and 6 am.**
- 7. A parent or guardian MUST stay overnight with a minimum of 1 parent/guardian per 5 youths. A list of overnight campers names (youth & adults) needs to be turned into the Extension office by 8 PM of the nights you are camping.
- 8. All payments must be made the day you reserve camp spot. No refunds. No holds. Exact cash or check only. Please make check to Wells County 4-H Association.
