



## Registering as a Judge in 4-H Online

If you registered as a judge last year and are re-registering this year, login to 4-H Online, <http://v2.4honline.com>, using the family credentials, click “Enroll Now” under the “Indiana 4-H Judges Registration” program next to your name, then skip to page 6 below in these instructions, “4-H Judge Enrollment”

If you are registering as a judge for the first time and your family has an existing 4-H Online account but need to add a new family member, login to 4-H Online, <http://v2.4honline.com>, using the family credentials then skip to page 4 below in these instructions, adding a new profile to the family.

If you are registering as a judge for the first time and you are a current or past 4-H volunteer with an existing 4-H Online account and profile, login to 4-H Online, <http://v2.4honline.com>, using the family credentials and skip to page 5 below in these instructions, creating a judges profile from an existing volunteer account.


Anyone new to the 4-H Online system begin on page 2 below in these instructions.


## Creating a New 4-H Online Account

If you already have an account in 4-H Online, you can login to your account and proceed to “4-H Judge Enrollment”.


1. Go to <http://v2.4honline.com>.
2. Click “Don’t have an account?” if you have never enrolled in 4-H before using 4-H Online.



3. Select Indiana from the drop-down menu.



4. Choose “State Office” as your county from the drop-down menu.



5. Complete your family's information.
6. Click the Create Account button.

## Adding a New Profile to the Family

1. Select the “Indiana 4-H Judges Registration” for the Program to join

2. Enter the profile information.
3. Click the Next button.
4. Complete the “About You” form with the requested information.
5. Click the Next button.

NOTE: fields marked with a red asterisk ( \* ) are required fields and must be completed.

6. Select your method of participation.
7. Click the Finish button. Then proceed to “4-H Judge Enrollment”.

1. Login to your 4-H Online family account. Find your name in your Member List
