Dear 4-H Goat Member:

It's that time of year again! The 2024 Howard County 4-H Fair is just a few months away. To exhibit your animal at the fair, please ensure that you meet the following requirements:

- **Identify animals in 4-H Online by May 15** at <https://v2.4honline.com/>.
- **Register animals in Fair Entry from May 17 through June 1** at <https://fairentree.com/>.
- **Complete QLC (Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care) training by June 1.** Information regarding this training is enclosed.

Goat tagging will occur on **Saturday, May 4, 2024, from 8:00 to 9:00 AM** at the 4-H Fairgrounds in Greentown. Goat check-in is **Sunday, July 7, from 7:30 to 9:00 PM**. The Howard County 4-H Goat Show is **on Monday, July 8, 2024, at 1:00 PM**.

Health papers are no longer required to exhibit animals at the Howard County 4-H Fair. However, the superintendent will inspect every animal, and any animal considered unhealthy or contagious WILL NOT be allowed to unload.

### **STATE FAIR**
